

ELPC Campaign for Illinois Clean Cars Act

The Environmental Law & Policy Center of the Midwest (ELPC) is currently working on a campaign to bring Clean Cars to Illinois. Illinois has the opportunity to become the 15th state to pass legislation that will ensure all new passenger vehicle and light-duty trucks will be more efficient and emit lower levels of air pollutants. This change will improve public health, save Illinois consumers money at the gas pump and help in the fight against global warming.

The Illinois Clean Cars Act is coming up for vote in the Illinois House of Representatives this November, as House Bill 3424. The Act will raise the average fuel efficiency standard for new vehicles sold in the state to 39.6 mpg. ELPC is asking constituents to contact their Illinois House Representative to tell them to vote YES for this bill. Clean Car Organizers will be present at the September 19 monthly meeting to give
