Rich's Ramblings Rich Carroll

The federal government has announced a system of electric vehicle charging corridors across the US. There will be 48 of these high speed charging corridors, covering almost 25,000 miles in 35 states. The Department of Transportation's goal is to have a high speed charging station available every 50 miles or less. This will enable coast to coast zero emission mobility. Twenty eight states (not including Illinois) have agreed to partner with DOT to hasten the deployment of these electric vehicle stations in the DOT corridors. In addition, 24 states (but not including Illinois) and local governments (but not Chicago, or any of the counties or municipal areas in northeast Illinois) have announced a partnership with the administration to increase the number of EV's in their fleets. Ideal charging deployment scenarios are yet to be determined, subject to two studies the Department of Energy is conducting. In addition the Department of Energy is continuing its Workplace Charging Challenge, and has signed up 38 new businesses, non-profits, universities, and utilities. The Federal Highway Administration has identified the carbon dioxide emissions from motor vehicles, which are the second-largest single source of pollution causing climate change. (behind the electric power sector.)

These corridors will be an important part of the federal government's plan to cut greenhouse gas emissions by 80% by the year 2050. This piggybacks and compliments the White House announcement in July of 4.5 billion dollars in loan guarantees to companies who are building EV charging stations nationwide.

The White House announcement seems to indicate a coordinated effort by the Fed. Highway Administration, the DOT, the DOE, and the Executive Branch of the government. There certainly will be difficulties along the way, but this sounds like a wonderful start to a solution to a very important problem.



Murphy's Law

3rd NDEW Site

Mike Willuweit mentioned the third Chicago area NDEW was in Evanston IL this year. George Gladic said there were several electric cars there including a Leaf, Volt and others, with drivers letting anyone drive.

Mike shared three announcements from Tesla

Tesla acquired Solar City and they have solar roofs that look like shingles

Free supercharging coming to an end by end of this year.

Limited to 400 hrs / year of free electricity

PRESENTATION BY STEVE CIMINO

Saturn Vue conversion from gas to Lithium back in 2008

The 2002 Saturn Vue is a smaller SUV hybrid from Saturn

In 2008 he ordered a kit from company on west coast to convert to electric. Stripped down the perfectly working car and converted to electric

Needed hub and adapter plate made and took to Pioneer Conversions in Lemont

John Emde, Rich Carroll, John Jeidi with Steve Grushas and others

Was going to put 20 x 6 volt lead acid batteries but then it was delayed 2 years

Lithium prices dropped from \$20k to \$10k so ended up putting them in 172 V Lithium battery pack Range 95 miles

He can go from Elk grove village to Blackhawks game and back

Converted to a water cooled controller instead of air cooled controller

Drives in 2nd gear

Steve thanked John Emde, John Jeidi, Ted Lowe, Rich Carroll for the excellent work they did on Steve's Saturn.

He has \$30k in the car after all the parts, labor and rebates

He thought everyone would see the brilliance of doing this conversion but not everyone sees it that way.

Figures he saved 3500 gallons of gas and saved 40 tons of C02

75 miles top speed

45 xThundersky 200Ah cells

25 in back and 20 in front under passenger seat

Bought low rolling resistance tires and keeps them at 48lb inflation pressure

Added special rear shocks and struts to hold the battery weight

Magnetic water conversion?

PRESENTATION BY BILL BECKER on Solar Electric Consumer Cars

Elon Musk is a visionary having created Paypal, Tesla, Solar City and Spacex

Triax solar panels have 25% efficiency and they think it may go to 35%

Germany will have no internal combustion engines by 2030

Do a Google search on solar electric boats will bring up 2000 electric boats

He built a 90 pound solar trike in early years

Described International race in Australia, 1800 miles total 315 miles per day

Showed several solar cars he had built

Solar cell efficiencies up to 48%

55 cents a watt today down from over \$100/watt years ago Sunpower plows 30% profits into research And they have solar flexible panels solar flex, 22x43 inches very durable 24% efficient today Showed many potential solar powered cars, Solar leaf, Cmax hybrid, Prius etc.

Meeting Adjourned at 9:30 p.m.

After the meeting William McDaniels showed a Tesla 5.3Kw battery pack he bought for around \$1,100
