


Just when you think that things are settling down in the world of batteries, surprising developments occur. We have known for some time that Lithium batteries heat and warp under rapid charging or discharging. Many pictures can be seen on the internet where lithium ion, lithium iron phosphate, or lithium poly batteries have overheated and distorted.

Several months ago, we purchased a Literati[®] e-book reader while it was on sale. It reads pdf's and epub files easily and has a good screen and a sD card for import. We find it easy to download an epub file, and take the Literati with us for vacations or just easy reading.

Two days ago, Rose, my wife came to me and asked what had happened to the Literati[®]. She said the case had opened, I knew of no incident, so went to look at it:







Obviously, the battery cell grossly distorted, likely due to heat. The Literati® was not warm when Rose found it, but we did not know how much prior the event had occurred. Several parts of this scared me:

- This must have overheated during charging, it was on a simple 117V charger (a 500 mA wall wart). It had been on the kitchen counter, away from other items or papers.
- How hot did it get? Could it have caused a fire in our home?
- Why did it overheat when charging with the small milliamp charger supplied? The lithium battery appears to have been somewhat contained by the design to disallow the battery from swelling or distorting, but this did not appear to be enough.

And the real question is with the batteries from an e-reader obviously distorting and overheating at normal charging, what should we watch for as we charge (or rapid discharge) lithium cells in an electric vehicle. There was no evidence of any failure of the 117V charger. Both the wall part and the "power cord" look perfectly like new.

As we consider batteries, some very high performance cars come with lithium batteries. I am aware that the McLaren MP4-12C and several Porsche models (the ones intended as track-day cars) use 12V lithium batteries as their primary battery. Here is an official Porsche picture of the lithium battery used in their 911 GT3 and 911 GT2 RS and Boxster Spyder track oriented models:



The Porsche battery has a suggested list price of \$1,700 and weighs 13 lbs, where the original was over 35 lbs. Porsche points out it is:

- Lower height by approx. 70 mm (over 35%)
- Almost 100% usable battery capacity
- Uniformly high power output, regardless of the charge state
- Improved charge take-up and a greater number of charge/discharge cycles
- Lower self-discharge and longer shelf-life

Porsche also noted, "Due to its design, the power output of the lightweight battery is limited below 0°C." The housing, shape, fastening system and electrical connectors are all identical enough to the sealed lead acid battery used in lesser Porsche models, to allow a quick swap in before race or track events. The Porsche battery has a nominal size of 18 Ah. Voltphreaks and Braille also ofter 12V replacement batteries for weight saving and racing use.

Bruce Jones opened the meeting at 7:03 and had newcomers introduce themselves. Old business – none.

National Plug-in Day Sunday September 23rd!

Dana Moreau the co-producer for the movie "Revenge of the Electric Car" described the National Plug-in Day event that we are hosting on Sunday Sept. 23rd at Community Christian Church. We have vendors like Nissan, Mitsubishi, Fisker and over a dozen electric vehicles including Tesla, Volt, Leaf and conversion vehicles from group members.

Media and newspaper coverage should be on site, so everyone bring their electric vehicles on Sunday.

Charging Station.

Next a discussion was held regarding the installation a charging station at the church. There are incentive programs from the state of Illinois and also from ChargePoint (Coulomb) providing free equipment. The next step, that has to happen quickly is for Bruce and Rich Carroll to work on a requirements document and get quotes for electrical work, trenching and installation.

The FVEAA has money in two funds from the EAA that Membership and special funds could be spend for the public such as charging stations

Grant Klufurtos the local Fisker Karma dealer located in Schaumburg brought his car and discussed the car. They have 9 vehicles and he has driven 6000 miles. The Fisker is a range extended vehicle like the Chevy Volt. It has 403 horsepower, 2 traction motors, 5300 lbs curb weight.

At the break several cars were on display including the Fisker Karma, and Chris Young S-10 conversion. After the break, about 20 minutes of the movie "Revenge of the Electric Car" was played and then final discussions on the charging station location at the church.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
